KINDERGARTEN CARE (KCARE) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME

What types of assistance are available?

- (1) MOE will provide a **Basic Subsidy** of \$150 to all Singapore Citizen (SC) children. No application is required.
- (2) An **Additional Subsidy** tiered according to income level will be provided to eligible applicant.

How to apply?

Application forms are available at the KCare centre. Please return the completed form to the KCare centre for onward submission to MOE. Parents will be informed of the application outcome via your KCare centre.
